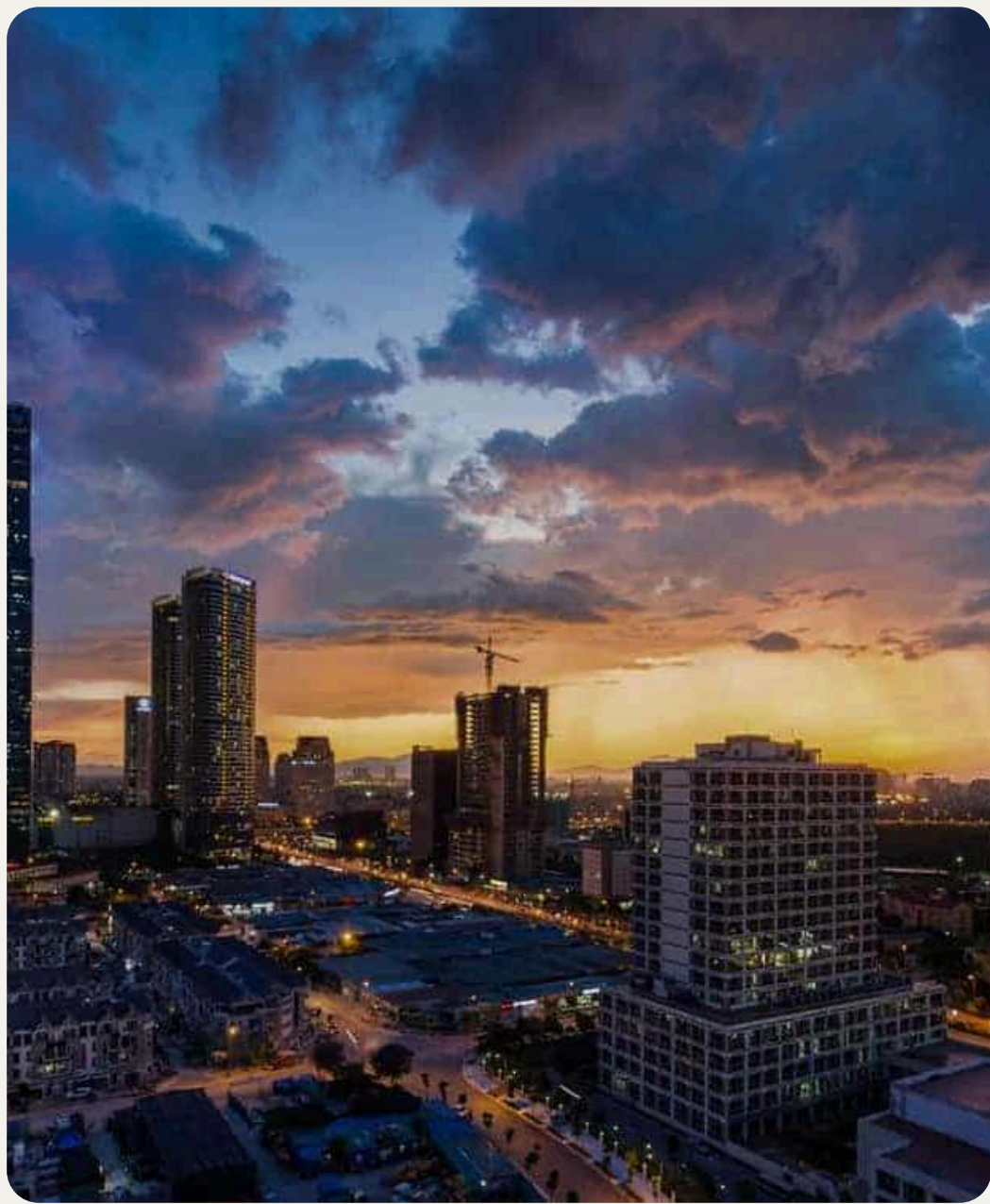


# Travel Itinerary

## Arrival At Hanoi

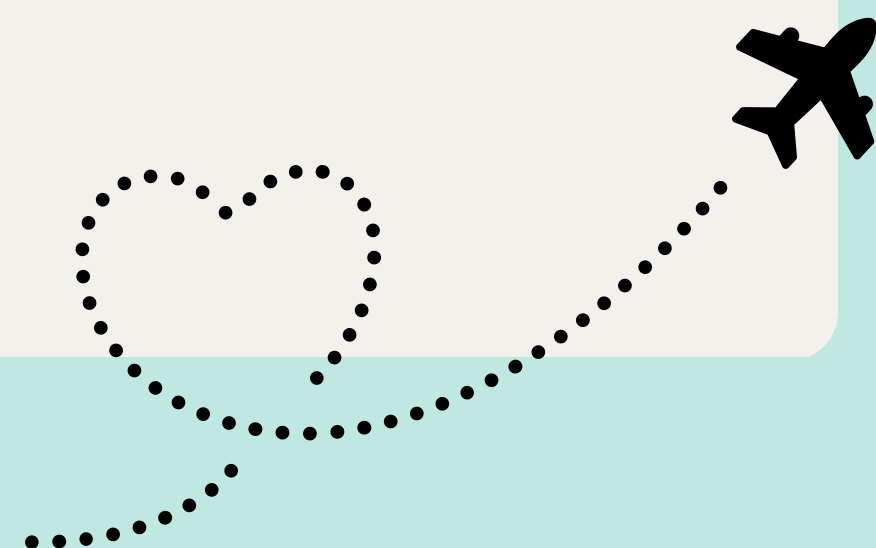

## Halong Bay

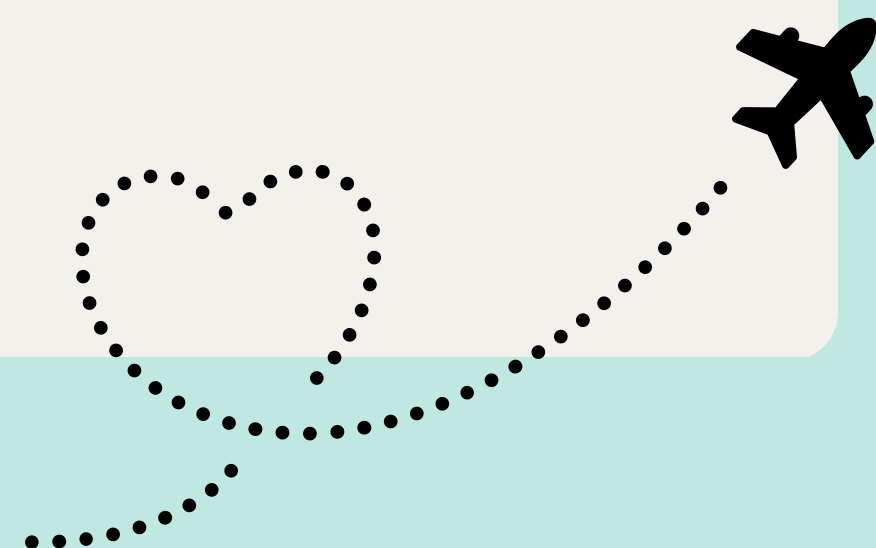
